NUS Faculty of Law collaborates with the World Trade Institute (WTI)

The Faculty took an important step to further expand its international trade law links by signing an agreement with [WTI](#) to collaborate in research and teaching activities in the field of international economic law.

Signed by WTI Managing Director, Prof. Thomas Cottier, and Dean Tan Cheng Han of NUS Law Faculty on 27th August 2004, the agreement brings together the Faculty's expertise in trade law issues, particularly with respect to the Asian region, and WTI's extensive network of trade law experts. The first project under the framework agreement is expected to be proposed and set up by 2005.

The WTI is hosted by the University of Berne, Switzerland and administered by the World Trade Institute Foundation. It is also associated with the Universities of Fribourg and Neuchâtel. The WTI conducts a well-known Master of International Law and Economics (MILE) programme.
