Tan Cheng Han SC '87 to represent Singapore as Young Global Leader at World Economic Forum

Our very own Law School Dean Tan Cheng Han SC '87 is one of 3 Singaporeans selected to be among the first 237 Young Global Leaders of the World Economic Forum, the independent Geneva-based organisation that holds an annual summit of global leaders at Davos, Switzerland.

The other 2 Singaporean Young Global Leaders are Member of Parliament Penny Low and Institute of Bioengineering and Nanotechnology executive director Professor Jackie Y Ying.

In an interview with the 'Today' newspaper on Wednesday, 12 January 2005, Cheng Han said: "Networks of idealistic people committed to doing good can always make our world a better place, if their hearts are in the right place. If this network can play a small role in helping shape the dialogue and facilitate some change, it will have been a worthwhile enterprise."

The inaugural Young Global Leaders Summit will be held in Zermatt, Switzerland, from 24 to 28 June 2005.
