Prof. Walter Woon '81 appointed Second Solicitor-General

The law school is pleased to welcome back Prof. Walter Woon '81, our former colleague and Vice-Dean who has spent the last nine years abroad in the diplomatic service. Walter is returning to Singapore to join the Attorney-General's Chambers as Second Solicitor-General. He was Singapore's Ambassador to Germany and lately to Belgium, while concurrently accredited to the European Commission, the Netherlands, Luxembourg and the Holy See. Walter will fill the post in the Attorney-General's Chambers left vacant by Lee Seiu Kin '86, who has been appointed a High Court Judge. As Second Solicitor-General, he will be working closely with Attorney-General Chao Hick Tin and Solicitor-General Chan Seng Onn '86. Like his previous diplomatic appointment, Walter will be on secondment leave from the law school.
