The National University of Singapore's (NUS) Faculty of Law is pleased to announce the appointment of Mr Lucien Wong, Managing Partner of Allen & Gledhill, as the newest member of its Advisory Board.

From 1 May 2008, Mr Wong will take up appointment as Advisory Board member with the stepping down of Mr K. Shanmugam, Senior Counsel, who assumes his duties as Singapore's Minister for Law and Second Minister for Home Affairs. The Chairman of the Advisory Board, Professor Tommy Koh, wishes to express the Board's deep gratitude to Mr K. Shanmugam for his many contributions to the work of the Board.

The Faculty of Law is also grateful to Mr K. Shanmugam for his valuable views and contributions over the past 7 years as a member of its Steering Committee from 2001 to 2006, and as a member of its Advisory Board from 2007 till present. The law faculty looks forward to his contributions to Singapore and the legal profession in his new capacity as Minister for Law.

Mr Wong, an alumnus of the NUS Faculty of Law, was admitted as an Advocate and Solicitor of the Supreme Court of Singapore in 1978 and has been in legal practice since that time. He joined Allen & Gledhill as a partner in 1987 and has been Managing Partner of Allen & Gledhill since 1998. He specialises in banking, corporate and financial services work.

Mr Wong was recently conferred a Special Award at the Chambers Global Awards 2007 ceremony held in London for outstanding contributions to the legal profession, becoming the first local lawyer to be conferred such an award.

The Advisory Board was appointed in February 2007 to replace a Steering Committee for the NUS Faculty of Law which was established in 2001 to advise the Dean of Law and the NUS Vice Chancellor, and to act as a liaison between NUS and the legal profession.
