The National University of Singapore (NUS) will be initiating a Search for the position of Dean of the NUS Faculty of Law. NUS is a leading global university in Asia and is internationally recognized for its research and teaching excellence. The NUS Faculty of Law is widely recognized as the leading law school in the region.

#### ABOUT NUS FACULTY OF LAW:

Located in Singapore, which for almost 200 years has been a major international commercial hub and a cosmopolitan city, the NUS Faculty of Law is Asia's foremost centre for legal research. It produces leading journals such as the *Asian Journal of Comparative Law* and the *Asian Journal of International Law*, as well as the *Singapore Journal of Legal Studies*. Its faculty consists of approximately 60 scholars from more than a dozen jurisdictions with active research in all major areas of law.

The Law School is also home to 1,200 undergraduate and postgraduate students. Degrees offered are the Bachelor of Laws (including double degrees in law and accountancy, law and business, law and economics, law and life sciences, and law and public policy), the Master of Laws (including a dual degree offered with New York University School of Law); and the Doctor of Philosophy.

#### JOB DESCRIPTION:

The new Dean is expected to provide intellectual leadership to the Faculty of Law, fostering and enhancing the law school's vibrant national and international reputation for research and teaching excellence. He or she will be expected to bring the Faculty to greater heights and to raise its profile nationally and globally. The Dean also oversees all aspects of the Faculty's administration, including academic affairs, financial management, operations and planning, fundraising, alumni outreach, student and faculty recruitment, and institutional building.

NUS seeks a candidate with a strong reputation as a scholar, and an outstanding track record of imaginative, strategic and visionary leadership. Candidates must be full professors with tenure at a distinguished law school. Candidates must also have excellent interpersonal skills to work collegially with faculty, staff, alumni, and other stakeholders.
