### **Ng-Loy Wee Loon promoted to Professor**

The Faculty of Law congratulates Ng-Loy Wee Loon on her promotion to Professor with effect from 1 January 2011.

Professor Ng-Loy is currently the Director of NUS Faculty of Law's LLM (Intellectual Property and Technology) programme.

She teaches the Law of Intellectual Property which focuses on Singapore's regime, as well as international IP modules (International Trademark Law and Policy; International Copyright Law and Policy). Amongst her academic publications is the text on Law of Intellectual Property of Singapore (2008, Sweet & Maxwell).

Outside of the University, her involvement in the IP scene includes the following: member of the Resource Panel for Government Parliamentary Committee for Law and Home Affairs (1999-2000); member of the Board of Directors of Singapore's IP office (2000-2001); member of the Board of Governors of the IP Academy, Singapore (since 2007); consultant to World Intellectual Property Organisation (2008-2009); member of Singapore's Copyright Tribunal (since 2008).
