 - CS/CU basis;
 - Will not count towards calculation of the class of honours.

 - Letter graded;
 - Will count towards calculation of the class of honours.
- JS and I&E I sequences are inter-changeable.
- Ideas and Exposition (I&E I) I must be read before Ideas & Exposition II (I&E II).
- SS sequences are inter-changeable, I&E sequences are not.
- For AY 2012/13, at College of Alice & Peter Tan SS I is taught in Semester 2 while Senior Seminar II is taught in Semester 1.
