8.30 hrs Land subsidence area & Planting Electricity efforts
 LCY Group - Photovoltaic Education Pavilion.
 There were many fish farms in Pingtung County's Jiadong
 past, Linbian. However, "land subsidence" became the
 biggest problem there, since four years ago. Typhoon
 Morakot crashed and people who lived in subsidence area
 were suffered terribly, but after reconstruction Today
 coastal subsidence area of more than 44 hectares raising
 water species electricity area, all kinds of elevated solar
 panels replace orchards and farming waste pond, face
 subsidence area is changing.

 With the changing times, the importance of Taiwan's
 aboriginal population gradually awareness of cultural
 preservation, and then on the advice of community

During Morakot typhoon crashed in 2009, Xiaolin village was attacked-hit by offering belly Rocky Mountains avalanche buried, resulting in 462 residents since buried, in memory of the dead and comfort the families of the victims, to the south of Highlands Xiaolin village site Xing provision Memorial Park, to provide villagers and visitors a rite to commemorate the place.
