#### Kevin Lee

Kevin is an independent practitioner focusing on public international law and international arbitration disputes. His recent practice highlights include acting as counsel for Italy in a State-to-State arbitration in the Permanent Court of Arbitration (PCA) and the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea, as well as advising a sovereign mediator in an inter-State maritime boundary dispute. Before assuming independent practice, Kevin was a member of the legal staff of the PCA in the Peace Palace, The Hague, where he worked under the auspices of the PCA for arbitral tribunals in State-to-State and investment treaty disputes.

An NUS LLB alumnus and Jessup mooter, Kevin holds a first class LLM from the University of Cambridge. He will be teaching a new course in NUS on “The Litigation and Procedure of State Disputes” in September 2017. In this talk, Kevin will speak about developing a career in the practice of public international law.
