

**SINGAPORE YEAR BOOK OF INTERNATIONAL LAW  
SUBMISSION AGREEMENT**

THIS AGREEMENT is made between the SINGAPORE YEAR BOOK OF INTERNATIONAL LAW (“the Publisher”), as agents of the National University of Singapore, and \_\_\_\_\_ (“the Co-Contributor”) with respect to the submission of \_\_\_\_\_ (“the article”).

**1. Exclusive Submission**

In consideration of the Publisher agreeing to consider publishing the article, the Co-Contributor warrants that the article is an original work that has not been previously published or simultaneously submitted for consideration by any other publication.

**2. Licence**

If the Publisher decides to publish the article, then in consideration of the Publisher agreeing to do so, the Co-Contributor grants the Publisher an irrevocable, transferable, sub-licensable, world-wide, non-exclusive, royalty-free right and licence to reproduce, publish and distribute the article in all media, whether currently existing or hereafter developed, including but not limited to print and any electronic services.

The licence is granted for the duration of the subsistence of the copyright, including any extensions and/or renewals.

**3. Indemnity for Liability**

The Co-Contributor warrants that the article does not infringe the copyright or any other rights of any third parties, does not contain any obscene, offensive, defamatory, or racially prejudiced material and will not expose the Publisher to any civil or criminal proceedings as a result of publishing the article.

The Co-Contributor agrees to indemnify the Publisher and its editors for any liability whatsoever incurred as a result of publishing the article.

**4. Choice of Law and Jurisdiction**

This agreement shall be governed by the laws of Singapore. The parties submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Singapore.
