

Comparison of Law Honours awarded in 11 UK law schools on Singapore's List of Overseas Scheduled Universities whose law degrees are recognised for the purposes of admission to the Singapore Bar

Based on the Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) 2015 Ranking of Law Schools, the only four UK law schools ranked above NUS are Cambridge (#2), Oxford (#3), LSE (#7) and UCL (#11).

Figures are based on UNISTATS data in the website provided by UK government (last accessed in September 2015).
