Priscila da Mata Cavalcante has been a prosecutor, in the Brazilian State of Paraná, for almost 13 years, in which she led the environmental unit of the Prosecutor's Office, in the Atlantic Forest. In this Seminar, Priscila will talk about the unique nature and role of the Brazilian Prosecutors, who sue not just private polluters but also the government for both civil and criminal offenses.

She will focus on constitutional and legal protections, which guarantee the Prosecutor's independence, and the cooperation with government and civil society institutions, including academia, that is necessary to fulfil the Prosecutorial mission. Finally, she will discuss key environmental cases from her professional experience, revealing the office's challenges, especially in the coastal environmental field pervaded by complex conflicts.
