Mohd Na'im Hj Mokhtar, Syariah Court of Appeal Malaysia</p> <p>This module will provide an in-depth analysis of the various modes of dissolution of marriages in Islam which are talaq, khuluk, faskh and ta'liq. It will also deal with issues surrounding the different modes of pronouncing talaq by elucidating the consequences and ramifications of each mode. Participants will be exposed to Quranic and Prophetic injunctions pertaining to dissolution of marriage in order to extrapolate general principles on the subject. Following that, this module will identify the distinction between hadanah (custody) and wilayah (guardianship) and how legitimacy of a child is establish in Islamic Legal System. The module will also contrast the diverse opinions within the Islamic tradition regarding separation focusing on the two dominant school of thoughts; The Hanafi and Syafi' mazhabs.</p>
