We do not invite applications from those with primary interests in the international law of the sea, ocean law and policy, or international environmental law.

The successful applicant may be offered a concurrent fractional appointment as a Research Assistant or Research Associate and designated workspace within CML, subject to availability. In addition to the CJ Koh Law Library, the successful applicant will also be given access to CML's own library of maritime texts and online databases, including i-law, Westlaw Asia, and Lloyd's List.
