



Justice S Mohan Judge, Supreme Court of Singapore



Justice S. Mohan' 92 was appointed Judicial Commissioner of the Supreme Court on 3 January 2020 and High Court Judge on 1 November 2021. He was called to the Singapore Bar in 1993 and specialises in maritime, shipping and international trade disputes, and accumulated more than 25 years of advocacy experience in legal practice as a maritime/shipping and international trade disputes lawyer. Prior to joining the Bench, Justice Mohan was the Managing Director of Resource Law LLC. Justice Mohan was also consistently recognised in legal directories such as Chambers Asia Pacific for his considerable shipping and admiralty experience. As a judge, Justice Mohan's areas of focus are shipping and admiralty, arbitration, banking and securities, complex commercial disputes, building and construction, and tort claims (including personal injury, defamation and professional/medical negligence).

Chan Leng Sun SC is a Senior Counsel of the Supreme Court of Singapore and a Chartered Arbitrator practicing with Duxton Hill Chambers. He is a member of the ICC Commission on Arbitration and ADR. He is formerly the Global Head of Arbitration of Baker McKenzie, President of the Singapore Institute of Arbitrators (SIArb) and Deputy Chairman of Singapore International Arbitration Centre (SIAC). He is the Deputy Chairman of the SGX Appeals Board, and a member of the Securities Industry Council which administers the Singapore Code on Take-overs and Mergers. Leng Sun is qualified in Malaysia, Singapore and England. He has a broad commercial practice and has acted as counsel or sat as arbitrator in arbitrations seated in Asia, Europe and USA under ad hoc and institutional rules, such as ICC, SIAC, AIAC, SCMA, LMAA, ICDR, CIETAC, HKIAC, KCAB and UNCITRAL rules. Leng Sun is a Specialist Mediator of the Singapore International Mediation Centre (SIMC). He is also appointed to the inaugural SCMA-SIMC Maritime Mediators Panel and the International Mediation Panel of KCAB International.
