

FIRST SUPPLEMENT TO THE CY-PRÉS DOCTRINE. By L. A. Sheridan and V. T. H. Delany. [1961, London, Sweet & Maxwell, Ltd. 8s. 6d. ix + 13 pp.]

The justification for the issue of this supplement is not so much the constant stream of cases and articles on this live topic but the impact of sections 13 to 15 of the (United Kingdom) Charities Act 1960.

As is well known, these provisions have attempted to reduce into statutory form (with some incidental amendments) the previous amorphous mass of case-law laying down the circumstances in which gifts may be applied *cy-prés*. The most important part of the supplement therefore consists of a reprint of the appropriate sections of the Act together with the authors' comments thereon, which place the new provisions into the framework of the existing law. In addition, a noter-up incorporates references to all the recent case-law and periodical literature.
