INDEX TO FOREIGN LEGAL PERIODICALS. Vol. 1 No. 1. Institute of Advanced Legal Studies, London, in co-operation with The American Association of Law Libraries. Quarterly. Subscription £9. 0s. or US \$25 p.a.

The American Association of Law Libraries has from 1926 published an *Index to Legal Periodicals* in which is to be found information on the contents of legal periodicals in the English language. Not unnaturally, the bulk of the references are to articles on law in the common law countries. The *Index to Foreign Legal Periodicals* seeks to provide similar information on the contents of legal periodicals of the world dealing with International Law (Public and Private), Comparative Law and the Municipal Law of the non-common law countries. The members of the Committee come from well known law libraries in the United States and the indexing has been done by specialists in English and European institutions.

The main index is the subject index in which under the appropriate subject heading and name of the country is given a reference to the title of the article in the language of publication, the name of the author, the name, volume number and page reference and date of the publication. The subsidiary indices are the author index and the geographical index. Book reviews of more than two pages are indexed separately.

Publication is to be quarterly and the fourth issue each year will be a cumulative one. Similarly, the last issue at the end of every five years is intended to be cumulative of the preceding years.

The *Index* is the answer to those who, with the increasing number of periodicals, find keeping track of articles in their interests a more and more exacting task.
