Bradford is the author of "The Brussels Effect: How the European Union Rules the World" (OUP 2020), which was named one of the Best Books of 2020 by Foreign Affairs. Her next book "Digital Empires: The Global Battle to Regulate Technology" will be published by the OUP in September 2023.
