Professor Tan Cheng Han, S.C. was Dean of NUS Law from 2001 to 2011 and is presently the Chief Strategy Officer at NUS Law. His other current roles include being a Senior Consultant at Wong Partnership LLP, President of the Law Society of Singapore, and a member of the Singapore Business Federation's Board of Trustees.
